1. Your memberlist and members activities?

2. When were Clones born on c-64 or Amiga?

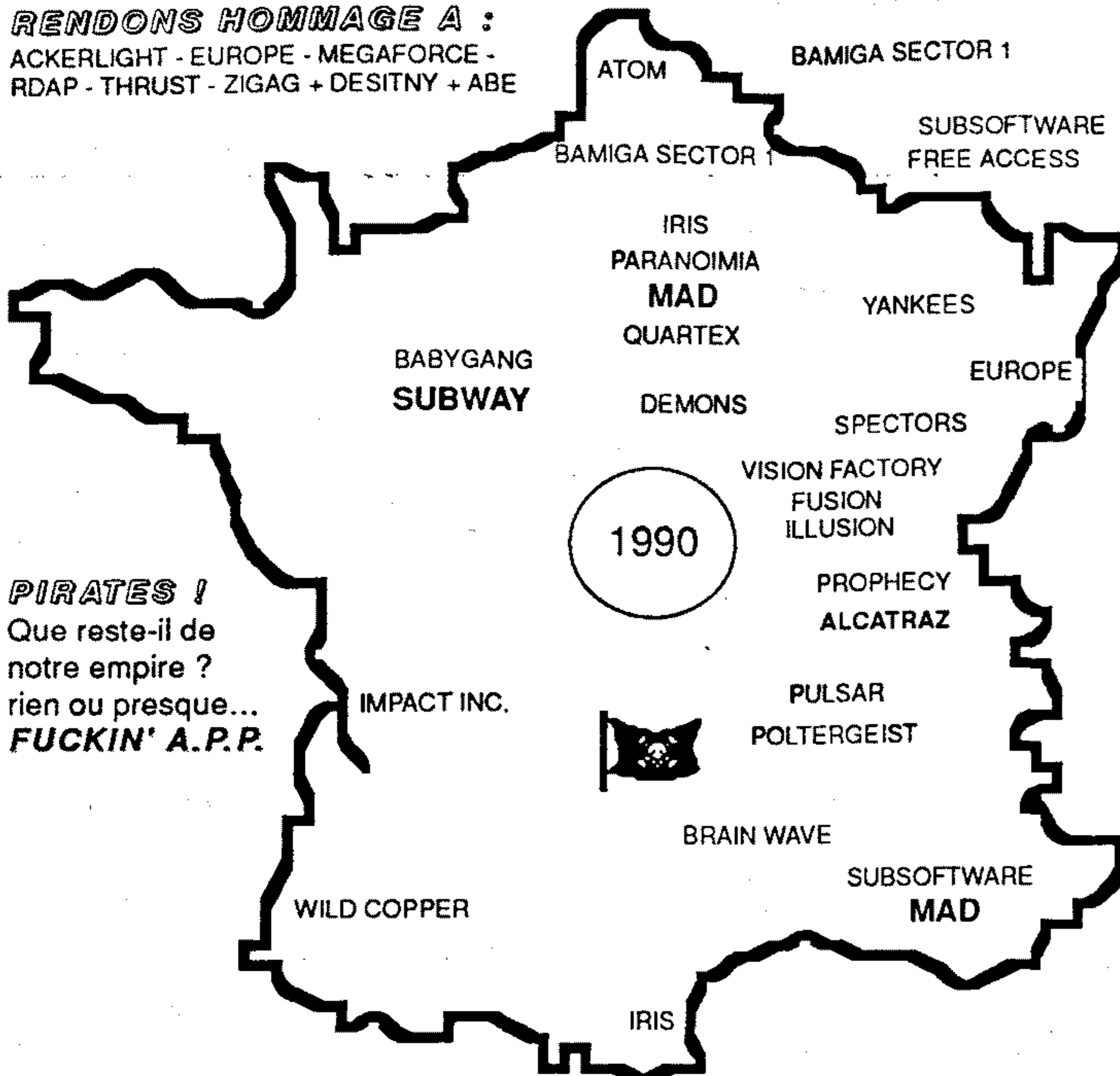

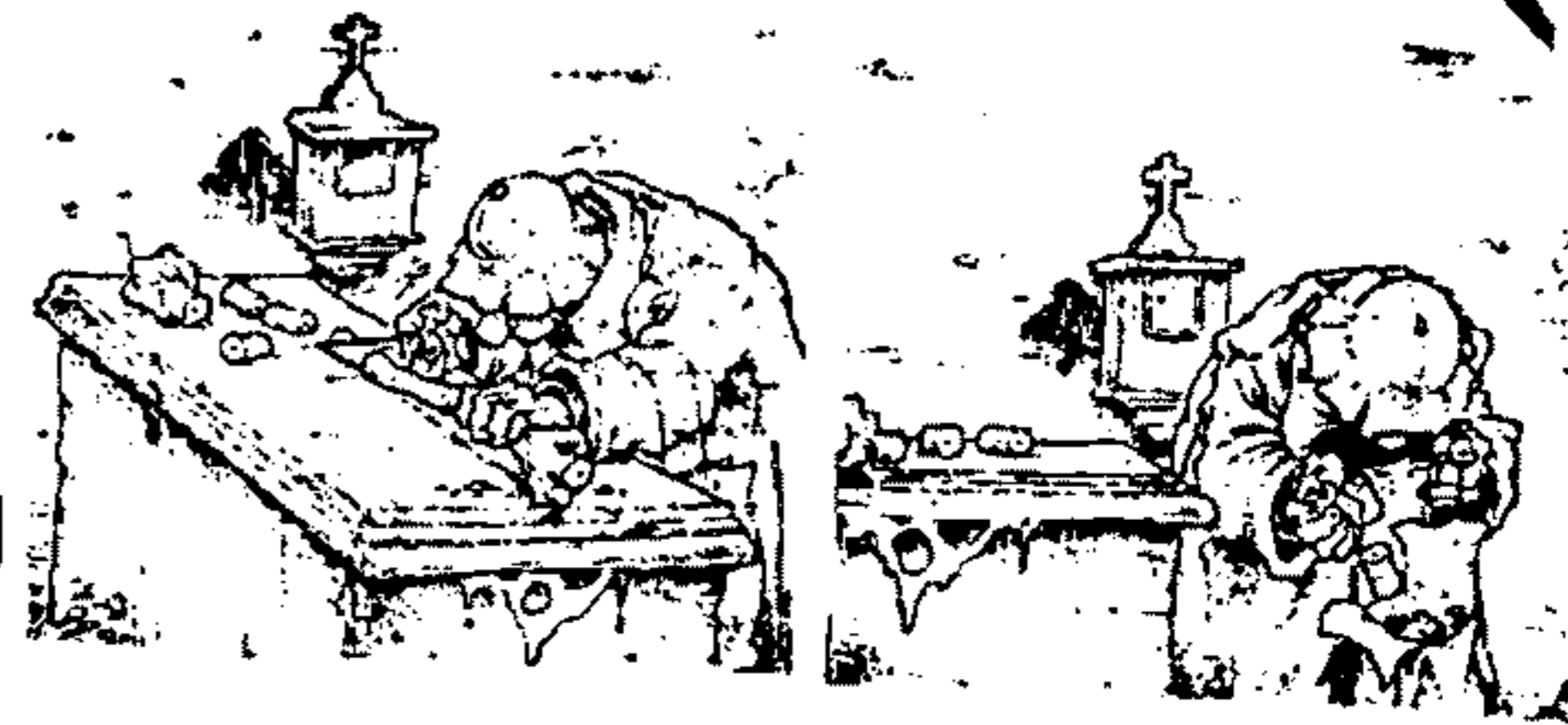
