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About This Guide

This document is designed to be used as step-by-step instructions for installation and as a reference for future upgrades.

Text Conventions

Installing and Maintaining Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51

This document gives you helpful information you need to install Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51 on your Compaq Professional Workstation. The installation instructions contained in this document are for use with Compaq SmartStart for Workstations version 1.10 or later.

Release Notes

Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51 Partition Sizes

During the Windows NT Workstation 3.51 installation, you are prompted to partition your hard drive. The Windows NT Workstation 3.51 Setup does not partition an NTFS partition greater than 4.0 GB or a FAT partition greater than 2.0 GB.

You can configure any remaining disk space by using the Windows NT Disk Administrator after Windows NT Workstation 3.51 is installed.

Updated Compaq Netelligent 10/100TX Driver

To connect your workstation to the network properly, you must use the network support software included in the Compaq Support Software for Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 SoftPaq. For information on how to obtain and install the support software, see the section "Obtaining and Installing Compaq Support Software."

Microsoft Service Packs

Microsoft Service Packs for Windows NT Workstation 3.51 are available from the Microsoft website (<http://www.microsoft.com>).

Compaq SMART Array Controllers Not Supported under Windows NT 3.51

Compaq SMART Array Controllers are not supported under Windows NT 3.51. You can use the SMART Array Controllers with Windows NT 4.0. For more information, see the Compaq website at <http://www.compaq.com> in the Compaq Services and Technical Help area.

Installing Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51 and Compaq Software

To install Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 and the Compaq support software, you need the following items:

- Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 CD and Setup diskettes
- Compaq Support Software for Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 (available as a SoftPaq from the Compaq website at <http://www.compaq.com> in the Compaq Services and Technical Help area under Downloadables)
- Compaq SmartStart for Workstations CD (included with your workstation)
- *Software Installation Guide* (included with your workstation)

After locating the items listed above, follow these steps to install the operating system and configure your Compaq Professional Workstation:

1. Prepare your system for software installation by installing or refreshing the Compaq Diagnostic Partition using SmartStart for Workstations. For more information, refer to the section "Preparing for Software Installation" in the *Software Installation Guide*.

NOTE: The Compaq Diagnostic Partition contains the Compaq Setup for Workstations (Computer Setup) and the Compaq Diagnostics for Workstations programs. You can access the diagnostic partition by pressing the **F10** key during startup. Depending on your Compaq Professional Workstation model, press the **F10** key after the blinking cursor moves to the top-right corner of your screen, or press the **F10** key when you see the words "F10=Setup" in the bottom-right corner of the screen.

2. Install the operating system. See the section “Installing the Operating System” later in this document.
3. Install the Compaq support software. See the section “Obtaining and Installing Compaq Support Software” later in this document.
4. Reconfigure the video display (optional). See the section “Reconfiguring the Video Display” later in this document.
5. Install Compaq Insight Management software (optional). See the section “Installing Management Products” later in this document.

Installing the Operating System



CAUTION: In certain cases, multiple operating systems can be installed on your Compaq Professional Workstation. If you already have an operating system installed, Compaq recommends backing up your workstation before any upgrade or installation operation is performed.

To install Windows NT Workstation 3.51, follow these steps:

1. Turn off the workstation.
2. With the workstation turned off, insert the Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51 Setup Boot diskette in drive A, then turn on the workstation.

NOTE: You must start the workstation using the Windows NT Workstation 3.51 Setup Boot diskette. Do not run WINNT.EXE or WINNT32.EXE from the CD.

3. Read and follow the installation instructions that appear on the screen. You will be prompted to choose *Express Setup* or *Custom Setup*. Compaq recommends that you use the *Express Setup* option for an easy and straightforward installation. Refer to the Microsoft documentation provided with your operating system for more detailed instructions about installing Windows NT Workstation 3.51.

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4. The Compaq Professional Workstation is equipped with the Integrated Wide-Ultra SCSI Controller. During Setup, follow these steps to add Wide-Ultra SCSI Controller support for Windows NT 3.51 Workstation:
 - a. After Setup detects the CD-ROM, select *S* to Specify Additional Device.
 - b. At the device selection screen, select *Other*.
 - c. When prompted, insert the manufacturer-supplied setup diskette and press the **Enter** key.

NOTE: Whenever you are asked to insert the manufacturer-supplied hardware support diskette, insert the Compaq Support Software for Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 diskette. Always insert diskette 1 unless prompted to do otherwise.

- d. When Setup displays Compaq 32-Bit SCSI-2 Controller and Compaq Drive Array, select the Compaq 32-Bit SCSI-2 Controller for Windows NT 3.51.
 - e. Setup displays the recognized devices: the CD-ROM and Compaq 32-Bit SCSI-2 Controller. Press the **Enter** key to continue installing the operating system.
5. Read and follow the Windows NT Setup installation instructions that appear on the screen. Be sure that *Unpartitioned Space* is highlighted, then press the **Enter** key to format the partition and install Windows NT Workstation 3.51.



CAUTION: Do not delete the diagnostic partition (EISA Utilities). This partition contains the Computer Setup, Inspect, and Diagnostic utilities.

6. The Compaq Professional Workstation is equipped with the Embedded Compaq NetFlex-3 Network Interface Controller. During Setup, follow these steps to add NetFlex-3 NIC support to Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 Workstation:
 - a. During Setup, the embedded NetFlex-3 NIC is not detected; select *Continue* to install the Network Adapter Card.
 - b. Select *Other* from the Adapter list.

- c. When prompted to provide the drive letter and path for the Windows NT distribution files, insert the Compaq Support Software for Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 diskette and type A:\NET\NETFLX3\ in the space provided.
 - d. Click *OK* and continue Setup. Follow the instructions on the screen.
7. If the workstation is equipped with the GLoria-L, GLoria-XL, GLoria Synergy, or MVP Workstation graphics controller, Setup will detect an s3 compatible display adapter. Click *OK* to confirm, then click *Cancel*. Install the ELSA or STB display driver as described in the section "Obtaining and Installing Compaq Support Software."



CAUTION: Do not click Test. This may cause the system to halt. The correct driver is installed later in the installation process. See the section "Obtaining and Installing Compaq Support Software."

8. When prompted, remove the CD and diskette from the drives, and restart the workstation.

Obtaining and Installing Compaq Support Software

You must install the following support software:

- ESS audio driver
- Matrox, ELSA, Diamond, or STB display driver
- Network and storage drivers
- Systems Management driver
- Windows NT 3.51 HAL

Obtaining Compaq Support Software for Windows NT 3.51

You can obtain support software for Windows NT 3.51 from the Compaq website at <http://www.compaq.com> in the Compaq Services and Technical Help area under Downloadables. You can download a SoftPaq that contains Compaq Support Software for Microsoft Windows NT 3.51 in one of these formats:

- A SoftPaq that contains a self-extracting executable file. Follow the instructions in the SoftPaq to unzip the support software files onto your hard drive.
- A SoftPaq that contains diskette images. You must have a 3.5" disk drive and blank diskettes available when you are ready to install the software. Follow the instructions in the SoftPaq to create the diskettes.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to use Compaq Support Software for Windows NT 3.51 version 1.25 or later.

Installing Compaq Support Software

To install support software manually, follow these steps:

1. With Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51 installed and running, log in with administrator privileges.
 2. From the Program Manager, double-click the Main group box icon, then double-click the Command Prompt icon. At the prompt, do the following:
 - a. Change to the directory that contains the support software files.
 - b. Type SETUP.EXE, then press the **Enter** key.
 3. To install the hardware support, click *Express*, then click *Update*.
 4. When prompted, restart your system to activate the installed.
 5. When your system restarts, the resolution defaults to the settings used by the new display driver you have just installed. This causes Windows NT to generate an Invalid Display Settings dialog box after you log in. To close the dialog box, click *OK*.

6. The Display Properties panel opens, allowing you to accept or change the default settings.
7. Click *OK* to accept the default settings of the new display driver or to save other settings you may have changed.

For more information, read the *NTREADME.HLP* file or run the *README.BAT* file located in the directory contains the support software files.

Reconfiguring the Video Display

To change the default settings for your video display, such as the screen resolution, color settings, and font sizes, follow these steps:

1. With Microsoft Windows NT Workstation 3.51 installed and running, log in with administrator privileges.
2. From the Program Manager, double-click the Main group box icon, then double-click the Control Panel icon.
3. From the Control Panel, double-click the Display icon.
4. Make any necessary changes to the display settings, then click *OK*.
5. Restart your system to activate the new display settings.

For more information about your display driver and about other utilities you can use with your graphics controller, refer to the appropriate guide in the X:\DOCS directory or X:\DOCS\GRAPHICS directory on the SmartStart for Workstations CD (where X is your CD-ROM drive designation). To view the guide, use the Adobe Acrobat Reader. Refer to the *Software Installation Guide* for more information about installing the Adobe Acrobat Reader.

The Compaq Management CD included with your workstation has the following software components:

- Compaq Insight Manager
- Compaq Insight Management Agents for Microsoft Windows NT
- Compaq Systems Management Toolkit
