Part 1. About the HDD adapter

With the *IBM ThinkPad 2nd HDD Adapter for Ultrabay 2000* (hereafter called *HDD adapter*), you can upgrade the capacity of your computer by installing a secondary hard disk drive into the Ultrabay 2000 bay of your computer.

To install the hard disk drive (hereafter called *HDD*) secondarily into your computer, you must first insert it into the HDD adapter, and then insert the HDD adapter into the Ultrabay 2000 bay.
